

Center for Student Opportunities Scholarship Fact Sheet for Students Central State University

DESCRIPTION:

The Center for Student Opportunities is offering an academic scholarship to recognize and encourage scholastic achievement. The academic scholarship is competitive and is based on academic achievement, interest and financial need. The Center for Student Opportunities academic scholarship is a one-year \$5,300 award which is granted at a rate of \$2,650 per semester. Selected students who meet the eligibility criteria will receive an award of \$2,650 in the semester. In order to receive the remaining \$2,650, a selected student must achieve and maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 by the end of the Fall semester. The student will then be awarded the additional \$2,650 at the beginning of the Spring semester. The University Council on Undergraduate Research reviews the applications for the scholarship and makes the final selections and awards. This scholarship is open to Central State University students majoring in Sciences, Business and Political Science departments.

ELIGIBILITY:

The eligibility criteria for acceptance into the scholarship program are:

- You must currently be a full-time sophomore, junior, or senior at CSU
- You must have a minimum GPA of 2.7
- You must submit an application and a letter of interest with a statement of your academic and career objectives, and a summary of your need for the scholarship.
- You must submit, along with your application form, two letters of recommendation from faculty members in the department of your major. If you are accepted into the program, you will receive an award of \$2,650. In order to be eligible to receive the full award of \$5,300, you must achieve and maintain a GPA of at least 3.0 during the Fall 2007 semester.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: The application deadline is April 1, 2008
