**SUBJECT: STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN
 COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES**

Students can participate in commencement exercises under all of the following conditions as verified by their chairperson and dean:

- After successfully completing courses during spring, 1998, the student will require no more than twelve credit hours to fulfill graduation requirements;
- Have been continuously enrolled over the last three quarters (unless no courses needed for graduations were offered);
- Some course(s) which were needed to graduate have not been offered, have been canceled, or have conflicted with other required courses during the last three quarters (including summer, 1998);
- Have not retaken or withdrawn from any courses during the last three quarters (including summer, 1998);
- Must show proof of pre-registration for summer school for the required course(s)/ credit hours needed and/or make appropriate arrangements through the chairperson to satisfy necessary graduation requirements.
