New Freshmen

Complete and submit the following to CSU Office of Undergraduate

Admissions:

1. Undergraduate Application
2. \$20 nonrefundable application fee (one-time fee)
3. High school transcript (partial one at the time of application; final one at end of senior year) or GED/High School Equivalence Diploma scores
4. Official ACT or SAT scores
5. Ohio Graduation Test (for Ohio residents only)

Transfer Students

(Students who have enrolled for credit at another college or university.)

Complete and submit the following to CSU Office of Undergraduate Admissions:

1. Undergraduate Application
2. \$20 nonrefundable application fee (one-time fee)
3. Official transcript from each college or university previously attended
4. A final high school transcript is required from students who are transferring with less than 30 semester hours (45 quarter hours)

If you have 45 quarter credit hours (30 semester hours) you must list an intended major.

Returning Students

(Students who have attended Central State University as a degree seeking student but have not registered for two consecutive semesters.)

Complete and submit the following to CSU's Office of Undergraduate Admissions:
