

## OHIO'S HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY OPTIONS

The Ohio Department of Education offers two testing options for those seeking to earn their Certificate of High School Equivalency: the GED and the HiSET exam. Ohio offers students the option of both online testing and traditional paper-pencil exams. Both the GED and HiSET are offered in English and Spanish.

There is a cost associated with each test, and vouchers may be available to help cover the cost.

**The GED Exam** offers computer-based testing only on the following subjects:

- Reasoning Through Language
- Arts
- Mathematical Reasoning
- Science
- Social Studies

**The HiSET** exam offers computer-based and paper-pencil testing. Students may combine testing option to include both formats. The following subjects are tested:

- Reading
- Writing (with essay)
- Math (calc. optional; whole test)
- Science
- Social Studies

**Successful completion of either the GED or HiSET will result in the student receiving the Ohio Certificate of High School Equivalency.**
