Dear Campus Community,

Decisions regarding the re-entry to Central State University are guided by protocols that represent the guidance of the governor, the Ohio Department of Health and the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Prevention. The transition back to campus will occur when the following conditions are met:

1. Gov. Mike DeWine permits or directs university campuses to reopen;
2. University leadership and trustees approve the scheduling and processes for reopening;
3. Sufficient resources are in place to support all CDC guidelines for personal protection and prevention;
4. Sufficient communication has occurred to inform and educate members of the campus community on the plan to reopen, any requirements for personal protection and prevention, and available resources for assistance; and
5. Attributes of a safe campus are met.

These conditions are in place to ensure a healthy environment for students, faculty, staff and campus visitors. When these conditions are met for re-entry, the process will be gradual and still have limitations that are in the best safety interest of the community.
