CSU Extension Hosts Free Fall Urban Agriculture Production Series

WILBERFORCE, OH – Designed for beginning farmers, Central State University Extension (CSUE) is offering a Fall Urban Agriculture Production Series. The Series will start on September 13, 2021 and run through October 4, 2021.

According to Michelle Wallace, CSUE agriculture & natural resources educator and presenter, participants will learn how to sample their soil for fertility, interpret soil test results, and how to amend their soil based on those results. “The series is also designed to help participants develop strategies to help them log and record their production activities, how to retrofit a raised bed using simple inexpensive materials to extend their growing season, and simple techniques to grow a variety of garlic in Ohio,” said Wallace.

Each program in the series will be held on Monday evenings from 6 pm to 7 pm. at Mott Library located at 1010 Dorr St, Toledo.
