Central State University Extension hosting “The Art of a Hydroponic Tower Garden” at CSU-Xenia facility

XENIA, OH –Central State University Extension (CSUE) will host its “The Art of a Hydroponic Tower Garden” program from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and repeating from 2 to 3 p.m., Thursday, Jan. 6, at CSU-Xenia, 334 Progress Dr., Suite 100, Xenia.

This is the first in a series of free gardening programs offered at the CSU-Xenia facility.
