CSU Marketplace holds mobile market on Sept. 14

WILBERFORCE, OH – The Central State University (CSU) Community Marketplace will be held 1:30 to 2:30 p.m., Tuesday, Sept. 14, in the parking lot of the Ward Center on the CSU campus, located at 1400 Brush Row Rd., Wilberforce.

The marketplace is free to all CSU students, staff and community residents, says CSU Extension Program Leader of Family and Consumer Science Dr. Mary Kershaw.

“All food is free,” she adds, “and we will not require proof of income. Our staff will ask all participants requesting food to complete an Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) Eligibility to Take Food Home form upon arrival.”

Participants need to bring their own bags or boxes for food items. Social distancing and masks may be required to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

“The Mobile Market is provided by the Dayton Foodbank, whose sponsors include United Way, Kroger, Human Services of Montgomery County and USDA.,” Dr. Kershaw says.
