### **“USDA-NRCS Assistance for Ohio Agricultural Producers” program at CSU-Xenia**

**WILBERFORCE, OH** –Central State University Extension (CSUE) will host a “USDA-NRCS Assistance for Ohio Agricultural Producers” program from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m., Thursday, March. 10, at CSU-Xenia, 334 Progress Dr., Suite 100, Xenia.

NRCS offers financial and technical assistance through conservation practices to help agricultural producers make and maintain improvements on their land. The 2018 Farm Bill offers programs such as the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) and Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP).

These programs provide funds to producers for implementing necessary conservation practices on their land. Producers from all types of agricultural backgrounds --- forest, crop and livestock --- look to NRCS for assistance on their operations.

Featured speaker USDA District Conservationist Meghan Moser will share how participants can benefit from the programs.

The program is free for adults over the age of 18.
