

Dr. Morakinyo A.O. Kuti serves as the Interim Dean of the College of Science, Engineering, Technology and Agriculture at Central State University (CSU). Dr. Kuti has secured over \$16.1 million in public and private funds that have enhanced Central State's physical infrastructure, enabled faculty research and scholarly activities, and provided students with scholarships and experiential learning opportunities. He has demonstrated a record of success facilitating positive outcomes for underrepresented students, particularly in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. Over 1,700 students have been positively impacted through Dr. Kuti's programs with 300 entering the workforce or graduate studies. Dr. Kuti leads the enhancement of CSU's research administrative infrastructure to meet and enhance the university's 1890 land grant mission, increase academic capacity, and improve retention and graduation rates. Dr. Kuti has made oral and poster presentations at national and regional conferences in research and research administration. He has administered \$225 million in public and private funds since 2005. Dr. Kuti holds a Bachelor of Science in Finance from Central State University, a Master of Business Administration in Finance from St. Thomas University, and a Doctor of Philosophy in Public Policy and Administration from Walden University.
