2022 Conference

The first annual Central State University (CSU) Extension All-Staff Conference was held Oct. 31-Nov. 2 on the CSU campus in Wilberforce, Ohio. The theme was **“Building Extension’s Future”** and was attended by 41 Extension professionals including campus-based staff, administrators, and regional staff in the four programs areas: Agriculture and Natural Resources, 4-H Youth Development, Community and Economic Development, and Family and Consumer Sciences.

The conference was an opportunity for the entire Ohio staff to tour the campus and see demonstrations and research taking place at the CSU Extension and Research Farm.

The presenters at the conference included a diverse group of professional motivational speakers, Extension educators, and program participants from both urban and rural areas.

An awards ceremony recognized professionals who have served with CSU Extension for five years or more. University staff were invited to a special Poster Presentation. The posters, created by the Extension Educators, highlighted many of the Extension programs. Personnel and students were able to view and vote on 24 posters which served to educate and raise awareness of Extension’s role within the University and the community at large. The Extension personnel also spent time interacting with ARD researchers involved with Evans Allen and McIntire Stennis projects.
