What Courses will I take?

Students will select a minimum of 12 Semester Hours offered at BAMSI. Students will be advised before registration to be sure the courses taken will transfer back to Central State to meet the requirements of their bachelor's degree program. Courses available – Biology, Mechanical Principles in Ag, Sustainable Ag, Soil Science, Ag Business, Animal Science, Grain Crops, Sustainable Ag Internship, Ag Policy, Farm Management

Highlights

Participants will spend the entire semester in The Bahamas, living as a student at the Bahamas Agriculture and Marine Science Institute. Students will meet with Government Officials and have the opportunity to explore the beauty of the country when not in class.

What is the cost?

The total cost of the program should be covered by your payment of tuition, fees, room, and board at Central State University. The only additional costs of the program may be incidental expenses incurred while studying abroad. Financial Aid and University Scholarships may be applied to the costs the same as if you were living on Central State's Campus.
