When accepting your awards, please note that the total amount is intended for the academic year, with disbursements split evenly between the Fall and Spring semesters. Opting for a lesser amount will also result in a proportional distribution across both terms.

## Financial Aid History Tab

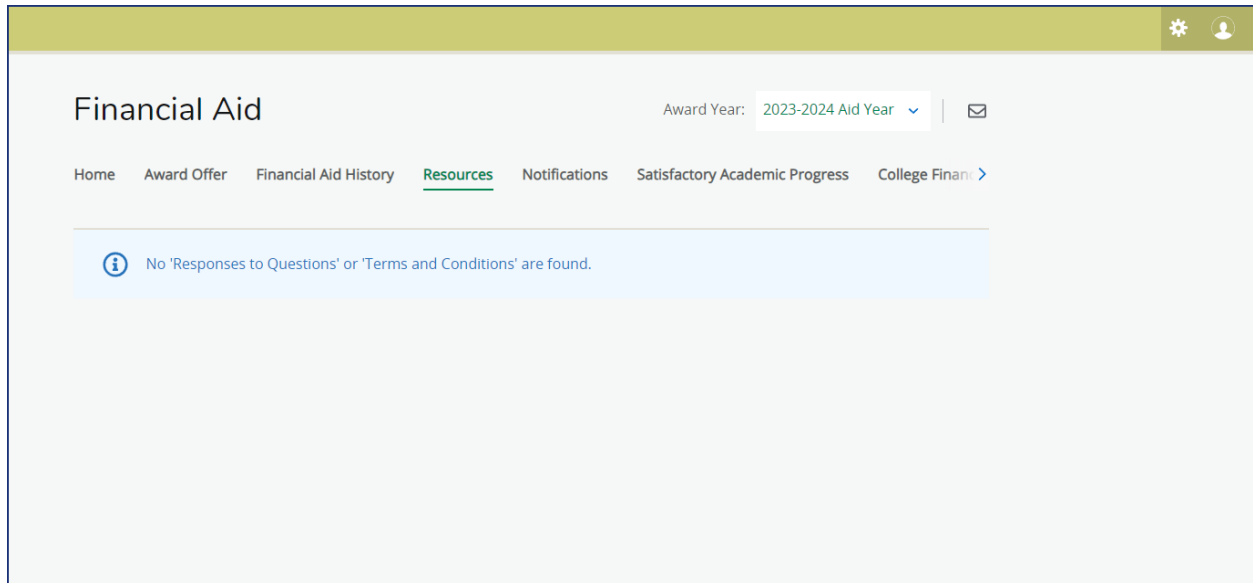
On the Financial Aid History Tab, you can view and compare your current award package to previous aid years. Use the drop-down box to view your awards by year.

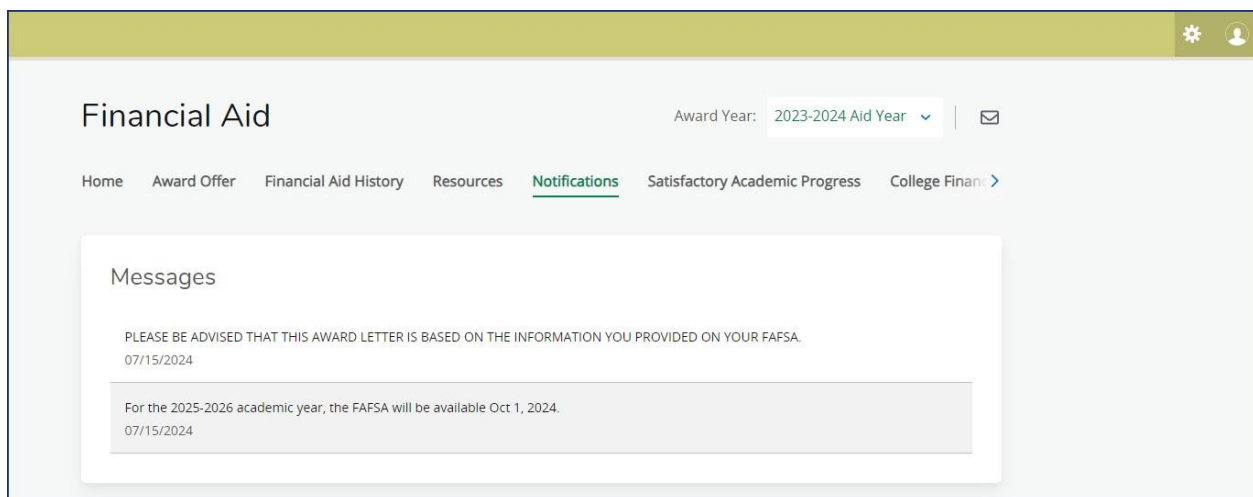
## Resources Tab
