Subject: STUDENT EMPLOYMENT

The basis for student employment is to assist in meeting the needs of Central State University (CSU), provide University students with financial support in pursuit of their academic goals, and provide opportunities for academic or administrative job experience. The job duties and responsibilities of student employees vary greatly and may or may not be related to their field of study.

1. The University maintains a distinction between student appointments and ongoing regular appointments. These distinctions may include but are not limited to nature of work, hours worked, degree required, rate of pay, and benefit eligibility.
